**Objectives:** Participants of the **ASIP CME Program in Pathogenesis** should be able to demonstrate an increase in, or confirmation of, their knowledge of the pathogenesis of disease after reviewing specific articles in *The American Journal of Pathology (AJP)*.

**Participants:** This program is specifically developed for trainees, clinicians and researchers investigating the mechanisms of disease who wish to advance their current knowledge of the cellular and molecular biology of disease.

**Deadline:** The deadline for receipt of the CME 2008 Registration Form, all Examination Answer Sheets and Evaluation Form is **January 15, 2009**.

**Instructions for Completing and Submitting Examination Answer Sheets:**

1. Photocopy the Examination in the back of each print edition of *AJP*, or download at [www.asip.org/CME/journalCME.htm](http://www.asip.org/CME/journalCME.htm).
2. Fill in the appropriate circle to indicate your answer to each question.
3. Enter your name and email address.
4. Mail or fax the completed Examination Answer Sheet along with your CME Registration Form\* and payment to the ASIP CME Office. 6. Correct answers will be emailed to you within 1 month after receipt of your Answer Sheet(s).\*\*
7. A CME Evaluation Form will be available in December 2008 and must be filled out and submitted by January 15, 2009.

\*\*You may mail or fax your completed Examination Answer Sheet to the ASIP CME Office after each issue is published in order to receive correct answers within 1 month, **OR** you may collect your completed Examination Answer Sheets throughout the year, and mail or fax to the ASIP CME Office at the completion of the 2008 CME year. The deadline for receipt of the CME 2008 Registration Form, all Examination Answer Sheets, and the CME Evaluation Form is **January 15, 2009**.
