Legibility is key! Text and labels in figure images need to be sized and spaced so that they are easy to read. Figures should be prepared so that all labels are crisp and large enough to be understood by the reader.

Avoid having to re-work your images by ensuring that clarity and resolution are addressed in initial preparation.
