Manuscripts in this category may be more descriptive and less mechanistic than Regular Articles, and must not exceed 12 double-spaced typed pages (excluding references and legends) and can include a maximum of 4 pieces of additional data (tables, figures, supplemental data). This total of 4 additional data pieces is cumulative, includes both main and supplemental files.
