Did you know...

The cover selection for *AJP* comes from figures submitted within the articles that appear in the issue. If you would like your work to be considered for the cover, please keep that in mind when preparing images for your submission. Authors can also submit a separate cover figure candidate from images related to the work in the article, even if the image itself is not included.

Single panel images should be provided as high resolution TIF files, with a resolution of at least 300dpi, while 600dpi is preferred. The editorial office will work with the authors to provide the cover tagline and legend for proper presentation.

If you have colorful, interesting, or otherwise unique images from your research, please feel free to suggest them for cover selection.
