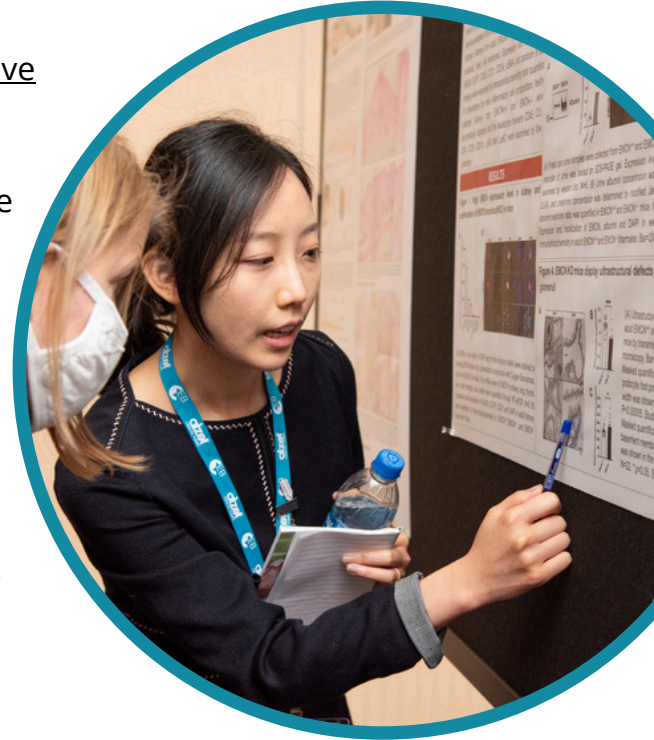

- Regularly scheduled virtual meetings, webinars, and hangouts

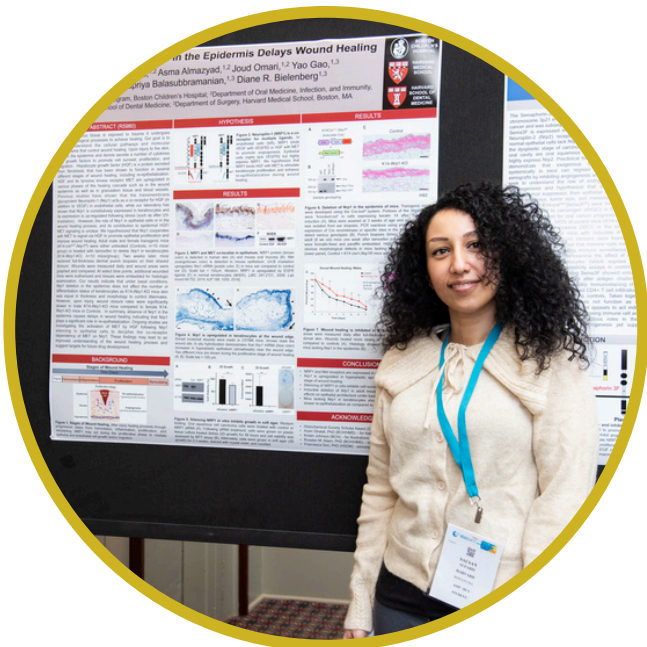
